

**Productivity Solutions Grant**  
**生产力提升计划**

The Productivity Solutions Grant (PSG) was introduced in 2018 to assist businesses in their transformation journey. Aligned to the Industry Transformation Maps (ITMs), PSG provides support for the adoption of IT solutions and equipment that have been selected by the respective industries' lead agencies<sup>1</sup>. The PSG is coordinated by MTI's Grants Management Office (GMO) and administered by relevant agencies.

**Key features of PSG**

2. PSG provides support for the adoption of pre-scoped, off-the-shelf productivity solutions that have been pre-approved by the respective industries' lead agencies.
3. It includes the following key features, which will better support businesses in the next phase of transformation, which may require more substantial investments and longer term commitments:
  - a. Funding of up to 70% of cost;
  - b. Pre-scoping of IT solutions and equipment with prequalified vendors (for IT solutions); and
  - c. Simplified grant processes.
4. As announced in Budget 2019, the PSG will be enhanced with a training subsidy to support employer-led training, on top of the support for the adoption of pre-scoped solutions. Successful applicants can use the training subsidy to cover 70% support, subject to a firm-level cap of \$10,000, for out-of-pocket training expenses.
5. More details on the training subsidy will be released at MOE's COS.

**Support Level and Eligibility**

6. The eligibility criteria for PSG remains the same. Successful PSG applicants will continue to receive up to 70% support for the adoption of the pre-scoped solutions, subject to the company-level grant cap.
7. PSG now covers sector-specific solutions for the Retail, Food, Logistics, Precision Engineering, Wholesale Trade, Environmental Services, Security and Tourism industry. Other than sector-specific solutions, PSG also support businesses' adoption of broad-based solutions that cut across all industries, such as Customer Relationship Management (CRM) and Human Resource Management (HRM) systems.
