

# AFA ON DIGITALISING BUILT ENVIRONMENT

## A STORY OF CREATING A DIGITALLY ENABLED BUILT ENVIRONMENT SECTOR

### ONE COMMON GOAL:

Digitalise built environment to build tomorrow's cities



### Achievement

Catalysed the launch of the Common Data Environment Data Standards, and introduced a two-stage training programme to equip value chain partners with the necessary digital tools and knowledge.

### How it was done

There was an unanimous goal to develop an interoperable and connected Integrated Digital Delivery ecosystem, to improve productivity across work process, nurture exportable digital capabilities, and strengthen the Cluster's resilience to external threats and shocks.

### Outcomes

- Generated a "pull effect" by establishing the Coalition for Built Environment Digitalisation, an industry digital partnership, with more than 300 companies and 25 projects onboarded within six months.
- Developed training initiatives to equip value chain partners, such as developers, contractors, and designers, with the necessary digital tools and knowledge.
