

## LIM HNG KIANG TO ATTEND THE INDIA-ASEAN BUSINESS FAIR & BUSINESS CONCLAVE (IABF) IN NEW DELHI, INDIA 1 – 2 MARCH 2011

- 1. Minister for Trade and Industry Lim Hng Kiang will attend the inaugural India-ASEAN Business Fair & Business Conclave (IABF) in New Delhi, India from 1 to 2 March 2011.
- 2. Organised by India's Ministry of Commerce and Industry, the IABF is an international conference and exhibition that aims to strengthen the economic ties between India and ASEAN by offering a platform for businesses to converge and develop possible business interests. The IABF is an initiative arising from the signing of the ASEAN-India Trade in Goods Agreement at the 41<sup>st</sup> ASEAN Economic Ministers Meeting on 13 August 2009. Participants include government officials and business leaders from various industries.
- 3. In India, Minister Lim will also meet HE Anand Sharma, India's Minister for Commerce and Industry.

4. Bilateral economic relations between India and Singapore are strong. In 2010, Singapore's total trade with India hit a record high of S\$30.7 billion, making India, Singapore's 11<sup>th</sup> largest trading partner.
