- 4. Recognising the important role of A*STAR, a new Chief Executive Officer (CEO) will also be appointed to assume the executive leadership role and responsibilities. More details of the CEO appointment will be announced in due course.
- 5. Mr Loh Khum Yean, Permanent Secretary for MTI, said, "I would like to express MTI's deep appreciation for Chuan Poh's many invaluable contributions. His strong leadership of A*STAR has strengthened Singapore's position as a Global Asia node of technology, innovation and enterprise. I would also like to take the opportunity to welcome Lai Fung to the MTI family. I am confident that the new leadership team will build on Chuan Poh's excellent work and bring A*STAR forward in its next phase of growth."
