MINISTER FOR TRADE AND INDUSTRY CHAN CHUN SING REAFFIRMS SINGAPORE'S LONGSTANDING AND ROBUST TIES WITH THE UNITED STATES

Minister for Trade and Industry Chan Chun Sing hosted a United States (US) Congressional Delegation led by US Senator Roy Blunt to a breakfast meeting today in Singapore. The visiting US delegation included Senators Debbie Stabenow, Roger Wicker, Mike Lee and Kevin Cramer, and Representatives Tom Cole and Jason Smith.

During the meeting, Mr Chan and the US Congressional Delegation affirmed the longstanding and robust relations between Singapore and the US, including the strong bilateral economic partnership. Both sides also recognised the importance of the US' continued engagement of Asia, and exchanged views on key regional and international developments.
