SINGAPORE IMPORTS FIRST SHIPMENT OF EGGS FROM POLAND

- 1 Minister for Trade and Industry Chan Chun Sing, Poland Ambassador Magdalena Bogdziewicz and Non-Resident Ambassador to Poland Dr Loo Choon Yong visited a Singapore importer's warehouse on Friday, 5 June 2020 to receive the first shipment of hen shell eggs from Poland. The eggs will be sold to restaurants and other F&B retailers.
- This is the first time Singapore is importing eggs from Poland. It is a concrete outcome of the Joint Ministerial Statement that Singapore and Poland issued on 29 May 2020 to affirm their commitment to strengthen economic cooperation.
- This is also part of Singapore's efforts to diversify our food supply sources to ensure our food supply remains resilient.
