



40,000 BUSINESSES RECEIVE SUPPORT THROUGH SMALL BUSINESS RECOVERY GRANT

- 1. Over 40,000 businesses received the Small Business Recovery Grant (SBRG) last week, amounting to a total of about \$132 million.
- 2. The SBRG was announced during Budget 2022 as part of the \$500 million Jobs and Business Support Package. It provides one-off cash support to small businesses in sectors most affected by COVID-19 Safe Management Measures last year.
- 3. Eligible businesses received \$1,000 for each Singapore Citizen/ Permanent Resident employee with mandatory CPF contributions employed from 1 November 2021 to 31 December 2021, capped at \$10,000 per firm. In addition, eligible sole proprietorships, partnerships, as well as hawkers, market and coffeeshop stallholders licensed by the Singapore Food Agency received a flat payout of \$1,000 even if they did not employ any workers during this period.
