

	<p>Mr Ang Cheng Hock, S.C. was appointed as Deputy Attorney-General (DAG) on 1 Oct 2022 for a term of two years.</p> <p>Prior to this, Mr Ang was appointed as Judicial Commissioner of the Supreme Court on 14 May 2018 and High Court Judge on 1 Aug 2019.</p> <p>Mr Ang graduated with a Bachelor of Laws from the National University of Singapore in 1995 and a Master of Laws from Yale Law School in 1998. He served as a Justices' Law Clerk in the Supreme Court in 1996 and 1997. He was called to the Singapore Bar in 1996.</p> <p>Mr Ang was a partner in Allen & Gledhill LLP and a member of its Litigation and Dispute Resolution department before his appointment as a Judicial Commissioner. His main areas of practice included civil and commercial litigation, international arbitration and corporate-related disputes such as shareholders' disputes, breaches of directors' duties, securities-related and banking litigation, defamation and professional liability. He had also represented clients in insolvency related litigation, shipping disputes and intellectual property disputes. He was appointed Senior Counsel in 2009. Mr Olivier Lim is Chairman of PropertyGuru Group Ltd and Certis CISCO Security Pte. Ltd.
