Mr Sopnendu Mohanty Chief Fintech Officer, MAS

Mr Sopnendu Mohanty is the Chief Fintech Officer of the Monetary Authority of Singapore (MAS) since August 2015 and Chairman of the Board of Elevandi (an MAS initiative) – A Global Convening Platform. He is responsible for creating development strategies, public infrastructure, and policies around technology-driven innovation.

Mr Mohanty has over two decades of public and private sector experience in technology, operations, digital finance and investment strategies.

He extensively engages with global technology and financial services ecosystems and has championed notable collaborative public goods like API Exchange (APIX), Singapore Fintech Festival. Payment Rails, Data exchange platforms and experimental programmes like Project Ubin. In addition, Mr Mohanty advises many international global advisory bodies on Fintech, Innovation and Inclusion. Within five years of his leadership, Singapore has become a leading global Fintech hub and was ranked as the top four global hubs in the Savills' Fintech index published by Savills World Research in 2023.

He has co-authored several patented works in the application of digital technology in Finance and won many industry recognitions.

Mr Mohanty holds a degree in Science from the Utkal University and a Masters in Information Science from the Birla Institute of Technology, India.

Ms Yong Hwee Yee is Vice President of Baxter International's Integrated Supply Pharmaceuticals and Compounding. Mr Chua also served as Deputy Secretary (Administration) at the Ministry of Defence, where he was responsible for the manpower, defence budget, digital transformation and legal issues.

Mr Chua started his career at the Monetary Authority of Singapore (MAS), where he was Executive Director (Strategic Planning and Communications Department) and Executive Director (Prudential Policy Department). He served as a member of the Executive Board of the International Monetary Fund from 2008 to 2010, during the global financial crisis. He was also a member of the Basel Committee on Banking Supervision's Policy Development Group, where he contributed to the development of the post-crisis bank regulation framework.

Mr Chua has served as a Board member of the Defence Science and Technology Agency and Chair of its Human Resource Committee. Mr Chua is currently a member and Audit Committee Chair of the Defence Science Organisation (DSO) Board, and a member of the JTC's Finance and Investments Committee.

Mr Chua graduated from Harvard University with a Master in Public Policy and recently, completed the Advanced Management Program at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology in 2023.

Mr Roland Krueger is Member of the Board of Dyson Holdings. He was Dyson's global Chief Executive Officer from April 2020 to January 2024 and before that, he was Chief Operating Officer. He joined Dyson in April 2019 as Global President of Automotive and Executive Director.

Mr Krueger is a global executive with extensive design engineering and management experience. Prior to Dyson, he was the Chairman & Global President of INFINITI Motor Company and Corporate Officer of Nissan. Mr Krueger also held a variety of senior executive roles with the BMW Group and design responsibilities at SMART, and Mitsubishi. Throughout his career, he has worked in Industrial Design and Engineering functions, as well as in various executive roles running major businesses globally, regionally and locally. He designed the interior of the first SMART car.

Mr Krueger studied Industrial Design at the University of Applied Science in Munich, Germany, and has an MBA from INSEAD, France.

Born in Munich, he has lived and worked in the US, France, Germany, Japan and Hong Kong. Mr Krueger now lives in Singapore with his wife. When he isn't in the office, he likes to compete in ultra-sports. He is the first German to ski through Antarctica to the geographical South Pole "solo" and "unsupported". Based on his achievements in polar exploration, he was appointed Member of The Explorers Club in New York.




Prof Tan Eng Chye President, National University of Singapore

Prof Tan Eng Chye was appointed President of the National University of Singapore (NUS) in January 2018. He is the University's 5th president, and the 23rd leader to head Singapore's oldest higher education institution.

Prof Tan is on the boards of National Research Foundation (NRF); National University Health System (NUHS); NUS High School of Mathematics and Sciences; and the University of Sharjah. He is a member of the Association of Pacific Rim Universities (APRU) Steering Committee and the immediate former chair of Universitas 21, a leading global network of 29 research-intensive universities. Prof Tan also sits on the International Advisory Council of the Southern University of Science and Technology in China and is an adviser with the think tank The Conference Board.

In 2022, Prof Tan was conferred the title of Knight of the French Order of the Legion of Honour (Chevalier de la Légion d'Honneur), the highest French distinction for military and civil accomplishments. His contributions in education and research have been further recognised through accolades like the Wilbur Lucius Cross Medal, awarded by Yale University in 2018, and honorary degrees from the University of Southampton in 2018 and Universiti Malaya in 2023.
