Chief Job Security Directorate Ms Caryn Lim is the Chief Executive Officer of *e2i* (Employment and Employability Institute). She leads efforts to strengthen workforce transformation, expand personalised employment support, and build strong industry partnerships. Under her leadership, e2i has grown its national reach to 27 touchpoints and launched initiatives such as the Accountancy Careers Hub and Tourism Careers Hub to provide targeted career support.

Ms Lim worked with government partners to develop and administer the Company Training Committee Grant, empowering businesses to drive workforce upskilling. She also enhanced the Job Security Council ecosystem, supporting the needs of employers and workers through both crises and peacetime.

Before joining e2i, Ms Lim was Director of NTUC's Economic and Social Policy Units, where she helped shape labour policy and supported Self-Employed Persons through the Self-Employed Persons Income Relief Scheme (SIRS), benefiting nearly 200,000 individuals during COVID-19. She also held key roles at the Ministry of Manpower, contributing to major initiatives like SPUR and the development of Singapore's CET campuses.
